Dear Parents,

From June 27th through August 12th, Spindle Rock Club will sponsor summer sail training programs on Cockeast Pond and the Westport River. Program activities are designed to satisfy a wide range of skills and interests, from a basic introduction to sailing on the pond, to racing instruction and an introduction to competitive sailing for more experienced sailors. We will use Vanguard 420s and Sunfish on the river and Hunter X-cites on the Pond. Following an initial swimming test and skill evaluation, we place participants in the most appropriate program level. To participate, children must be at least eight years old on May 1st 2022. We will consider applications for younger children provided they have had previous sailing experience and successfully pass a swimming test administered by a sailing instructor.

Our program also includes special events such as pirate days and a final cookout.

The program will begin on June 27th and end on August 12th. Private lessons can be arranged throughout the summer and will still be available after August 13th. Please provide an email address so we may send notices about where and when to report, as well as scheduled times for lessons. We will also post them on bulletin boards at Spindle Rock Club and Elephant Rock Beach Club.

Weller Henderson, an experienced sailing instructor, will again lead our Junior Sailing Program for the 2022 Spindle Rock Club sailing season. Weller came up through the Spindle Rock program, has been an instructor here for five years, and is very experienced with our boats and the Westport River. He understands the needs of junior sailors and his enthusiasm is a driving force for our students. Brice Giblin, Holland Erickson, Brogan Panos and Beatrice White are all graduates of the Spindle Rock sailing program and are also returning as instructors. We are thrilled to have their experience again, especially as they have proven their successful skill and creative approach to making the program safe and fun throughout the Covid challenges. Willy Underwood is our newest instructor joining us this season. Willy has been both a student in the sailing program and brings both excellent skills and experience, together with strong enthusiasm and positivity. All Spindle Rock Club instructors have been certified in CPR and first aid training. All instructors have either completed, or are actively working toward, certification in the U.S. Sailing Instructor's Program.

We do our best to place students in their chosen classes, but from time to time, factors such as scheduling, space, and equipment make it hard to accommodate all requests. In those situations we will try to find a suitable alternative. If there is enough interest for a class at a time that is not on our schedule, we can add another class. Since our program is designed not only to provide basic sailing instruction and an opportunity to develop sailing skills, but also to encourage collegiality and collaboration among participants, we require registration for a minimum of four classes.

We look forward to seeing you and your junior sailor this summer.

Notes on Program:

The Spindle Rock Sailing Program begins June 27th and ends August 12th. On August 12th there is a cookout and awards ceremony for students and their parents. All sailing staff will be at the cookout, so this is a great chance to discuss a student's progress and say goodbye for the year. During July and August there will be at least one pirate day for each sailing class, the dates of which will be determined based on student and instructor availability.

We have tried to create the class schedule such that there are enough classes and times to support our load of students each year based on past enrollment. Class Levels and Times

Explanation of Student Skill Levels

Beginner – Little or no prior instruction and/or sailing experience. Will be introduced to relevant parts of the boat, operation of a sailboat, and points of sail. Must sail with an intermediate student or instructor until confident enough to operate the tiller or main sheet (or both) without instruction.

Intermediate – Demonstrates effective boat steering and sail operation and can explain them to a beginner sailor. Understands basic points of sail and can tack/jibe. Can rig and tie a proper cleat. Able to right a capsized boat by themselves or with a fellow student. Has had exposure to effective docking techniques at the floating dock in the pond.

Advanced - has passed knots, rigging, tacking, jibing, reaching, beating, and running. Can handle most landings and mooring pickups, and can recognize wind and current force and direction. Can right a capsized boat on their own and get out of irons.

Expert/Racer – an accomplished sailor who can dock, moor, get out of irons, and sail backwards. Can easily tack, jibe, and correctly trim sails. Knows sailing rules and is working on perfecting sail trim, boat handling, right of way and reading tide/currents. Can maneuver effectively in close proximity to other boats.

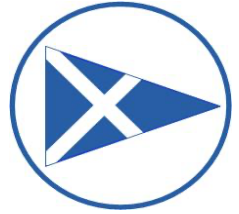
